STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to incorporate the Executive Committee of Huntoon Hill Grange, Number Three Hundred Ninetyeight, Patrons of Husbandry.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Silas Y. Jackson, William S. Damon, Ezra 2 S. Perkins, and their successors are hereby created a body 3 politic and corporate, by the name of the Executive Com-4 mittee of Huntoon Hill Grange, Number Three Hundred 5 Ninety-eight, Patrons of Husbandry, for the purpose of 6 holding real and personal estate, and managing and dis-7 posing of the same for the use and benefit of said Grange.

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Sect. 2. Said corporation may take by purchase, devise 2 or otherwise any real or personal property and hold the 3 same, for the purposes aforesaid, to an amount not exceed-4 ing four thousand dollars, exempt from taxation, and may 5 manage and dispose of the same at the discretion of said 6 grange.

Sect. 3. Said corporation shall choose annually such 2 officers as may be necessary for their own government, and 3 have the right to prosecute actions at law and in equity, 4 and adopt a seal and code of by-laws not inconsistent with 5 the laws of the State.

Sect. 4. Vacancies by death, resignation or otherwise 2 shall be filled by said Huntoon Hill Grange from the 3 membership thereof.

Sect. 5. Any two persons named in this act, may call 2 the first meeting of this corporation, by written notice, 3 delivered or mailed each corporator, at least five days 4 before the time of said meeting.

Sect. 6. This act shall take effect when approved.
