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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD, ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT to amend the charter of the President and Trustees  
of Colby College.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. That section three of the act entitled "An Act  
2 to establish a Literary Institution in the District of Maine,  
3 within this Commonwealth," passed by the General Court  
4 of Massachusetts and approved February 27, 1813, and from  
5 time to time amended, be further amended by inserting after  
6 the word "trustees" in the eleventh line thereof the following  
7 words: 'except as hereinafter provided,' and by adding to  
8 the end of said section the following words: 'And provided  
9 also that nine of the trustees shall be elected by the Alumni  
10 Association of Colby College, to be known as "Alumni

11 Trustees” and to be elected, three each year, for terms of  
12 three years, in such manner as said association may provide.’

So that said section three as amended shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 3. Be it further enacted, that for the more orderly  
15 conducting the business of the said corporation, the president  
16 and trustees shall have full power and authority, from time  
17 to time as they shall determine, to elect a vice president,  
18 treasurer and secretary of said corporation, and to declare  
19 the tenure and duties of their respective offices, and also to  
20 remove any trustee from the said corporation, when in their  
21 judgment he shall be rendered incapable by age or other  
22 ways, of discharging the duties of his office, and to fill up all  
23 vacancies in the said corporation, by electing such persons  
24 for trustees, except as hereinafter provided, as they shall  
25 judge best. Provided, nevertheless, that the number of the  
26 said corporation, including the president of the said institu-  
27 tion, and the treasurer for the time being, shall never be  
28 greater than thirty-one, nor less than twenty-one. And pro-  
29 vided also, that nine of the trustees shall be elected by the  
30 Alumni Association of Colby College, to be known as  
31 “Alumni Trustees” and to be elected, three each year, for  
32 terms of three years, in such manner as said association may  
33 provide.’

Sect. 2. The first three of the trustees herein provided for  
2 shall, for their first term, be elected during the year 1904,  
3 the second three during the year 1905 and the third three  
4 during the year 1906.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
