IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 194 of the Public Laws of 1901 entitled "An Act additional to chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes relating to Bowling Alleys."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Chapter 194 of the Public Laws of 1901 is
- 2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "alleys" in the
- 3 second and fifth lines the word 'pool, bagatelle and billiard
- 4 rooms,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:
 - 'Sect. 1. Any person licensed to own, keep and operate a
- 6 bowling alley, or bowling alleys, pool, bagatelle or billiard
- 7 rooms in this State under the provisions of chapter twenty-
- 8 nine of the Revised Statutes, may be granted permission by

9 the municipal officers of the town or city where said bowling 10 alley or alleys, pool, bagatelle or billiard rooms are situated 11 to keep the same open until midnight, when in the opinion 12 of such municipal officers no person or persons residing in 13 the immediate neighborhood will be disturbed thereby.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
