IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT for the better protection of deer in the county of York.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. No person shall take, catch, kill, chase or hunt
2 any deer in the county of York, except during the month of
3 October of each year, and no person shall during the open
4 season in this county, take, catch, kill or have in possession
5 more than two deer or parts thereof. Whoever shall violate
6 any of the provisions of this section shall be subject to a
7 penalty of one hundred dollars and costs for each offense.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of Octo-
2 ber, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and
3 three.
