IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to provide in part for the Expenditures of Government
for the year nineteen hundred and three.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. In order to provide for the several acts and
2 resolves of the legislature, requiring the payment of money
3 from the treasury, and also to provide for the necessary
4 expenditures of government for the current fiscal year of
5 nineteen hundred and three, the following sums are hereby
6 appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury, and the gov-
7 ernor, with the advice and consent of the council, is author-
8 ized at any time prior to the first day of January next, to

9	draw his warrant on the treasury for the same.
