STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT establishing the salary of the County Attorney for the County of York.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The county attorney for the county of York

- 2 shall receive an annual salary from the treasurer of State
- 3 of one thousand dollars, payable quarterly on the first day
- 4 of January, April, July and October of each year, beginning
- 5 on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and three, instead
- 6 of the salary now provided by law.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 are hereby repealed.
