STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making appropriations for the Passamaquoddy
tribe of Indians.

Resolved, That there be paid from the State treasury, to
2 be expended under the direction of the governor and council,
3 to the agent of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians, for the
4 benefit of said tribe, for the years nineteen hundred and three
5 and nineteen hundred and four, as follows: For May divi-
6 dends, four hundred dollars each year; for November divi-
7 dends, four hundred dollars each year; for distressed and con-
8 tingent poor, four thousand dollars each year; for contingent
9 purposes, two hundred dollars each year; for bounty on crops,
10 two hundred dollars each year; for plowing, one hundred
11 and fifty dollars each year; for salary of governor, one hun-
12 dred dollars each year; for salary of lieutenant governor,
13 forty dollars each year; for fertilizers, one hundred and fifty
14 dollars each year; for salaries of priests, three hundred dol-

15 lars each year; for agricultural purposes, six hundred dol-
16 lars each year; for salary of agent, four hundred dollars each
17 year; for educational purposes, eight hundred dollars each
18 year; for basket ash, three hundred and fifty dollars each
19 year; for wood for nineteen hundred and three, seven hun-
20 dred and fifty dollars; for wood for nineteen hundred and
21 four, six hundred and fifty dollars; for school books, thirty
22 dollars each year; for police at Pleasant Point, fifty dollars
23 each year; for seats for school room at Pleasant Point, for
24 nineteen hundred and three only, one hundred and twenty-
25 five dollars; for repairs of Sisters' house at Peter Dana's
26 Point, for nineteen hundred and three only, fifty dollars; for
27 repairs of road at Peter Dana's Point, one hundred dollars
28 each year; for painting school house and hall at Peter Dana's
29 Point, for nineteen hundred and three only, sixty dollars.
30 Total for nineteen hundred and three, \$9,255.00.
31 Total for nineteen hundred and four, \$8,920.00.
