RESOLVE, in favor of roads in the Indian Township, Washington County.

Resolved, That the sum of eight hundred dollars (\$800) be and is hereby appropriated to repair roads and bridges in the Indian Township, Washington county, for the year nineteen hundred and three, and six hundred dollars (\$600) for the year nineteen hundred and four.

Said appropriations to be expended under the direction of the governor and council.
