Resolved, That there be paid from the State treasurer to
2 the agent of the Penobscot tribe of Indians for the years
3 nineteen hundred and three and nineteen hundred and four
4 to be applied for the benefit of said tribe each year as follows :

5 Interest on tribe's fund, each year.....	\$4,429 70
6 Agricultural purposes, each year.....	850 00
7 Annuity, each year.....	1,700 00
8 Bounty on the crops, each year.....	200 00
9 Schools, each year.....	650 00
10 Salaries, each year,	
11 Agent of tribe.....	\$400 00
12 Governor of tribe.....	50 00
