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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT to authorize the town of Athens to remove the bodies  
of deceased persons.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The town of Athens is hereby authorized to  
2 take up from the old burying-ground in the village in said  
3 town the bodies and remains of all deceased persons buried  
4 therein, and all head stones and markers at the graves therein,  
5 and remove the said bodies and remains to the new burying-  
6 ground in said town and there decently bury the same, and  
7 properly reset such head stones and markers over such dead  
8 bodies and remains, at the expense of said town; and to sell  
9 and convey all the right and interest said town has in the old

10 burying-ground; provided that said town of Athens at any  
11 legal meeting or meetings, duly called and notified, shall  
12 agree thereto, by a majority vote of its legal voters present  
13 and voting.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
