STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT relating to the Young Women's Christian Association of Portland, Maine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Young Woman's Christian Association 2 of the city of Portland, Maine, a corporation organized 3 under the laws of this State and located at said Portland in 4 said county of Cumberland, is hereby authorized and 5 empowered to hold by deed, devise, bequest or otherwise, 6 property, personal and real to the amount of fifty thousand 7 dollars. Sect. 2. The acts and doings of the meeting of said 2 corporation held on the twelfth day of May, A. D. 1902, 3 are hereby ratified, confirmed and declared to be legal and 4 valid.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
