IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter forty-two of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred ninety-nine relating to the taking of Black Bass in certain lakes in Kennebec and Somerset counties, also Sabattus pond in Androscoggin county as amended by chapter two hundred eighty-seven Public Laws of 1901.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. of chapter forty-two of the Public Laws of 2 eighteen hundred ninety-nine as amended by chapter two 3 hundred eighty-seven of the Public Laws of nineteen

4 hundred one is hereby amended by adding thereto after the  
5 words “also Keoka lake in Oxford county,” the words,  
6 ‘also Highland lake in the northern part of Cumberland  
7 county.’

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
