STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT relating to the election and term of office of certain members of the board of assessors, board of overseers of the poor and female members of the school committee of the city of Portland.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The term of office of the members of the
2 board of assessors and of the members of the board of
3 overseers of the poor of the city of Portland which have
4 been elected by the city council of said city for a term of
5 three years from the second Monday in March, A. D.
6 1901, shall expire on the second Monday in December,

7 1903, and the elections of a member of said board of
8 assessors and four members of said board of overseers of
9 the poor on the second Monday in December; A. D. 1902,
10 by said city council, are hereby declared to be legal, and
11 all acts performed by either of said officers since their
12 election and qualification for said offices are hereby con-
13 firmed and made valid, and their term of office shall be for
14 three years, or until their successors are elected and
15 qualified.

Sect. 2. The election of a female member of the school
2 committee of the city of Portland for a term of two years
3 at the annual municipal election in December, A. D. 1902,
4 is hereby declared to be legal, and all her acts as a member
5 of said committee since her election and qualification are
6 hereby confirmed and made valid, and all future elections
7 of the female members of said committee shall be at the
8 annual municipal elections in December and for a term of
9 two years.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
