IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the city of Calais relating to
ward and district lines.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section nine of chapter 325 of the Private Acts
2 of 1883 is hereby amended by inserting in the fourth line
3 after the word "ward" the word 'lines' and by inserting in the
4 fifth line before the word "district" the words 'may alter or
5 abolish existing,' and by inserting in the fifth line after the
6 word "lines" the words 'and may establish voting districts
7 in any ward and fix the lines thereof,' so that said first sen-
8 tence shall read as follows:

'Sect. 9. The city shall remain divided into seven wards
10 and ward seven shall remain as now divided into district
11 number one and district number two, and the council may,
12 once in ten years revise and, if needful, alter the ward lines,
13 and may alter or abolish existing district lines, and may
14 establish voting districts in any ward and fix the lines thereof
15 so as to preserve, as nearly as may be, an equal number of
16 voters in each ward.'
