## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit the use of purse and drag seines in the waters of Sargentville Harbor, known as Billings Cove.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The use of purse and drag seines is hereby

- 2 prohibited in the waters of Sargentville Harbor, known as
- 3 Billings Cove, under a penalty of not less than five, nor more
- 4 than fifty dollars.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
