STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT establishing the jurisdiction and term of office of
women appointed to solemnize marriages, administer oaths
and take acknowledgments of deeds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The appointment of any woman under the laws
2 of the State to solemnize marriages, administer oaths and take
3 acknowledgments of deeds shall authorize her to act within
4 and for every county of the State, and said appointment shall
5 continue for the term of seven years.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
