STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prevent the throwing of sawdust and other mill waste into Saint Georges River in the towns of Montville, Searsmont and Appleton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No person or persons shall cast or throw into
2 the Saint Georges river in the towns of Montville and Sears-
3 mont, in the county of Waldo, and Appleton in the county of
4 Knox, any sawdust, edgings, heading turnings, shavings,
5 bark or other mill waste, or place or deposit such mill waste,
6 or other refuse, along the banks in such a manner that the
7 same shall fall or be washed into said Saint Georges river.

Sect. 2. Any person violating the provisions of section one
2 shall be subject to a penalty of not less than five dollars and
3 not more than fifty dollars, to be recovered in an action of
4 debt by any party injured, or by indictment.
