STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to change the name of Burnt Island in the town of North Haven to Scallop Island.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The island known by the name of Burnt Island 2 being and lying near the northeast point of the town of North 3 Haven, containing fifteen acres, more or less, belonging to 4 Francis W. Chandler of Boston, Massachusetts, is hereby 5 changed to the name of Scallop Island.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
