STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to allow the inhabitants of the plantation of Moose
River to assess and collect taxes, to build and keep in repair
the roads and bridges in said plantation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The inhabitants of the plantation of Moose
2 River, Somerset county, are hereby authorized and allowed
3 to assess and collect taxes on the property in said plantation,
4 for the purpose of building and keeping in repair the roads
5 and bridges in said plantation.

Sect. 2. Said inhabitants are also authorized and allowed
2 at their annual town meetings to elect a road commissioner,
3 or commissioners, or highway surveyors to expend the same.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
