STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing the land agent to sell certain public lots in E plantation and Portage Lake plantation, in Aroostook county.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized to sell 2 and convey to actual settlers thereon certain lands in E plan-3 tation and Portage Lake plantation, in Aroostook county, 4 constituting part of the school lots of said plantations, if he 5 deems advisable, for such price per acre and on such terms of 6 payment as he may deem advantageous; provided, that in 7 making sales of said lands the legal and equitable rights of 8 persons claiming under said settlers shall be considered and 9 preserved; and provided, also, that the proceeds of any sales 10 made shall be added to the school funds of said plantations.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In these plantations farms have been cleared and settlements made upon ministerial and school lands, and many of these farms have been occupied for twenty years or more. The object of this resolve is to allow the land agent to give the settlers a title to their homesteads.
