STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to authorize Frederick J. Merrill of Damariscotta to
construct a tide wheel in tide waters of the Damariscotta
river.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Frederick J. Merrill is hereby authorized to
2 build and maintain a tide wheel in the tide waters of the
3 Damariscotta river, and within the limits herein described
4 as follows: Beginning on the east shore of said Damariscotta
5 river, on the land of said Frederick J. Merrill, at low water
6 mark, thence running northwesterly forty feet, and of width
7 sufficient to successfully run and operate said wheel, provided
8 said wheel shall not obstruct navigation.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
