### STATE OF MAINE.

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the "Moose River Log Driving Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1 of chapter 179 of Private and Special Laws of

- 2 1879, is hereby amended as follows: By striking out, in
- 3 the thirteenth and fourteenth lines, the words "Moose River
- 4 bridge," and inserting in their place the words 'head of Attian
- 5 pond and of Wood pond,' so that said section, as amended,
- 6 shall read as follows:
- 'Sect. 1. That Elias Milliken, Joseph S. Bradstreet, Frank-
- 8 lin Smith, C. B. Foster and Abner Coburn, their associates
- 9 and successors, be and they are hereby made a body politic
- 10 and corporate by the name and style of Moose River Log
- 11 Driving Company, and by that name may sue and be sued,

12 prosecute and defend to final judgment and execution, both 13 in law and in equity, and may make and adopt any all reg-14 ulations and by-laws not repugnant to the constitution and 15 laws of the State, and may adopt a common seal, may hold 16 real and personal estate, sufficient to carry on successfully 17 the business of the Moose River Log Driving Company, and 18 may grant and vote money for the same. And said com-10 pany shall drive all logs and other timber coming into Moose 20 river, between the head of Attian pond and of Wood pond 21 and Moosehead lake for the purpose of being driven to 22 market. And said company may for the purposes aforesaid 23 remove obstructions, erect booms and dams, where the same 24 may be lawfully done, and may use steam or other power for 25 the purpose of towing logs and booms, and shall have all the 26 powers and privileges and be subject to all the liabilities, 27 incident to corporations of a similar nature.'

Section 7 of said act is amended by striking out the word 29 "Wednesday" in the fourth line thereof, and inserting in its 30 place the word 'Tuesday,' so that said section, as amended, 31 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 7. The first meeting of said company may be called 33 by any one of the corporators named in this act, by written 34 notice to each member. Annual meetings shall be called by 35 the clerk on the third Tuesday of February in each year, or 36 at such times as the company may vote, by giving fourteen 37 days' notice in some newspaper published in Kennebec or 38 Somerset county; special meetings may be called by order of 39 the directors, with like notice.'
