STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of George B. Haskell, Jacob R. Little and Stephen J. Kelley, in payment of witnesses', magistrates' and officers' fees and disbursments made by them in the city of Lewiston contested election case.

Resolved, That the sum of six hundred dollars and twenty-2 eight cents is hereby appropriated, and that the State treasurer 3 be and is hereby authorized and directed to pay said sum of 4 six hundred dollars and twenty-eight cents to George B. 5 Haskell, Jacob R. Little and Stephen J. Kelley, the sitting 6 members, for witnesses', magistrates' and officers' fees and 7 disbursments made by them in contesting their seats in the 8 house of representatives, in the contested election case of the 9 city of Lewiston.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

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The foregoing resolve is to reimburse Messrs. Haskell, Little and Kelley for expenses and disbursments necessarily incurred after the election in the city of Lewiston in obtaining evidence and prosecuting their contest for seats in the House.
