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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT authorizing the town of Madison to purchase with  
the town of Anson in the county of Somerset the Norridge-  
wock Falls Bridge.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The town of Madison in the county of Som-  
2 erset is hereby authorized and empowered to raise money  
3 by taxation, or otherwise, to purchase with the said town of  
4 Anson the bridge across the Kennebec river between the  
5 said towns of Madison and Anson, erected by and belong-  
6 ing to the proprietors of Norridgewock Falls bridge.

Sect. 2. Said town of Madison is hereby authorized and  
2 empowered to take and purchase with the said town of

3 Anson said bridge and franchise, with all the rights,  
4 powers, privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging,  
5 on payment to said proprietors of said bridge such sum  
6 therefor as may be mutually agreed upon by said towns  
7 and said proprietors; each town to pay such part of such  
8 sum, or purchase price, as they shall mutually agree upon;  
9 provided, that after such purchase said bridge shall be de-  
10 clared free for public travel and use.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
