IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT authorizing the Lewiston Trust and Safe Deposit
Company to establish a branch at Freeport.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Lewiston Trust and Safe Deposit Com-
pany is hereby authorized to establish a branch at Freeport
in the county of Cumberland.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
