STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT amending section one of chapter 284, of the Public Laws of 1893, in relation to ways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The words "not within" in the third line of 2 said section one are hereby stricken out and the words 3 'outside of the thickly settled portion of are substituted 4 in their place; so that said section as amended will read 5 as follows:

Sect. 1. When it is necessary for any person or per-7 sons, by themselves, men or teams, to cross or enter upon 8 any tract of land outside of the thickly settled portion of 9 any town, for the purpose of hauling supplies, wood, bark, 10 logs or lumber, or to yard or land the same, such person 11 or persons shall not be liable in any action of trespass 12 therefor, provided, the bond is furnished as provided in 13 section two, but the person or persons carrying on said 14 lumbering operation, shall be liable for all the actual dam-15 age done to said land by said men and teams so crossing 16 said land.'
