STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT additional to chapter seventy-three of the Revised Statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 73 of the Revised Statutes is hereby 2 amended by adding thereto the following section, to wit:

'Sect. 30. No agreement that a building erected with 4 the consent of the land owner, by one not the owner of 5 the land upon which it is erected, shall be and remain per-6 sonal property, shall be effectual against any person, ex-7 cept the lowner of such land, his heirs, devisees and 8 persons having actual notice thereof, unless such agree-9 ment is in writing and signed by such land owner, or by

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10 some one duly authorized for that purpose, and acknow-11 ledged and recorded as deeds are required to be acknow-12 ledged and recorded under this chapter.'

Sect. 2. This act shall not apply to said agreements 2 heretofore entered into and now outstanding.
