IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to permit ice fishing in Pease pond on Saturdays of  
each week during certain months.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. So much of section 5 of chapter 42 of the Public  
2 Laws of 1899 as prohibits fishing through the ice in Pease  
3 pond, in the town of Wilton, Franklin county, on Saturdays  
4 of each week during the months of February, March and  
5 April, is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
