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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and forty-nine of the  
Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five,  
entitled "An Act to divide the town of Sullivan and incorporate  
the town of Sorrento."

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 1 of chapter one hundred and forty-nine  
2 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and  
3 ninety-five is hereby amended by inserting after the words  
4 "Simpson's Island" in the twelfth line of said section the  
5 words 'Sheldrake or Sullivan's Island, Ash Island, and Junk  
6 of Pork together with the shore or flats belonging to said  
7 islands,' so that said section as amended, shall read as fol-  
8 lows:

‘Sect. 1. All that part of the town of Sullivan in the county  
10 of Hancock, and State of Maine, known as Waukeag Neck,  
11 which lies south of Long Cove, west of Bass Cove, and south-  
12 west of a line running from Long Cove to Bass Cove,  
13 described as follows, namely: beginning at the center of the  
14 stream which runs in a northwesterly direction into said Long  
15 Cove at the point where said stream joins said Long Cove at  
16 mean high water mark just west of the bridge crossing said  
17 stream, thence south, thirty-seven degrees east about seven-  
18 teen hundred and sixty feet to said Bass Cove, including  
19 Ingall’s Island, Bean’s Island, Dram Island, Calf Island,  
20 Seward Island, Preble or Simpson’s Island, Sheldrake or  
21 Sullivan’s Island, Ash Island, and Junk of Pork, together  
22 with the shore or flats belonging to said islands, together with  
23 the inhabitants thereof, is hereby incorporated into a separate  
24 town by the name of Sorrento; and said town is hereby  
25 invested with all the powers and privileges and subject to all  
26 the duties and obligations incident to other towns of the  
27 State.’

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
