## STATE OF MAINE.

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prevent the destruction of smelts in the waters of the towns of Lubec and Trescott in the county of Washington.

#### Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from taking 2 smelts in the waters of the towns of Lubec and Trescott in 3 the county of Washington, by the means of purse or drag 4 seines, or gill nets.

Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate the provisions of this act, 2 shall on conviction of the same before any municipal court 3 or trial justice of said county of Washington, be punished 4 by a fine not less than ten dollars, nor more than twenty

5 dollars, or by imprisonment in the county jail, for a term 6 of not less than ten days, and imprisoned in said jail for same 7 time, for non-payment of fines.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
