RESOLVE in favor of Knox County General Hospital.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
3 of fifteen hundred dollars to be paid to the Knox County
4 General Hospital for the use of said institution, for the year
5 nineteen hundred and three, and fifteen hundred dollars for
6 the year nineteen hundred and four.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Knox County General Hospital and training school for nurses was opened in August, 1902, and the sum of fifteen hundred dollars per annum is asked to be appropriated by the State of Maine to aid in the maintenance and support of this institution. The hospital is doing a worthy work in furnishing accommodations for sick and maimed persons in Knox and surrounding counties.
