STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Home for Friendless Boys.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated twenty-
2 five hundred dollars for the use of the Maine Home for
3 Friendless Boys at Portland, as follows: one thousand two
4 hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and
5 three and one thousand two hundred and fifty dollars for the
6 year one thousand nine hundred and four.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The managers of the Maine Home for Friendless Boys in Portland are constantly and earnestly working to increase its funds from private sources that they may be able to provide for the wants of the boys in the institution. The aid from the State is a great help to the Home and the funds are judiciously used.
