RESOLVE in favor of the Eastern Maine General Hospital.

*Resolved,* That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum  
2 of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to be paid to the Eastern  
3 Maine General Hospital for the use of said institution for the  
4 year 1903, and five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the use of  
5 said institution for the year 1904.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Eastern Maine General Hospital is patronized by the people of Eastern Maine, and is an institution of great benefit to the section of the State in and around Bangor. It is managed by some of the best citizens of the community and is doing a noble work in furnishing medical and surgical attendance to the poor as well as to the rich.
