IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit spitting upon the floors of street cars.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Whoever spits upon the floor of any street car
- 2 shall be fined not less than two nor more than ten dollars to
- 3 be recovered on complaint.
- Sect. 2. The officers of all street railroad companies shall
- 2 cause a copy of the preceding section to be posted in their
- 3 several street cars.
