IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit spitting upon the floors of street cars.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. Whoever spits upon the floor of any street car  
2 shall be fined not less than two nor more than ten dollars to  
3 be recovered on complaint.

Sect. 2. The officers of all street railroad companies shall  
2 cause a copy of the preceding section to be posted in their  
3 several street cars.
