STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Eastport Street Railway

Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the East2 port Street Railway Company which were granted by chapter
3 four hundred and sixty-five of the laws of eighteen hundred
4 and ninety-seven, and extended by chapter one hundred and
5 seventeen of the Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine,
6 and further extended by chapter two hundred and sixty-eight
7 of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and
8 one, are hereby further extended for and during the period
9 of two years from the seventeenth day of March, nineteen

10 hundred and three, and all the rights, powers and privileges
11 that were granted and acquired by virtue of or under said
12 acts may and shall be exercised in the same manner and for
13 the same purposes as provided in said chapter four hundred
14 and sixty-five.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the seventeenth day 2 of March, nineteen hundred and three.
