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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT to repeal so much of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 42 of the Public Laws of 1899, as prohibits fishing in Goodwin brook, and Higgins stream above the first dam, tributaries to Moose pond, in Somerset county.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. So much of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes, 2 as amended by section 5 of chapter 42 of the Public Laws of 3 1899, as closes Goodwin brook to all fishing, and Higgins 4 stream above the first dam, tributaries to Moose pond, in 5 Somerset county, is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
