### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to provide for the protection of deer on the island of Mount Desert.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt, chase, pursue,

- 2 catch or kill any deer at any time in the towns of Eden, Mount
- 3 Desert and Tremont, in Hancock county, under the penalty
- 4 provided in the general law for illegal hunting or killing of
- 5 deer.
