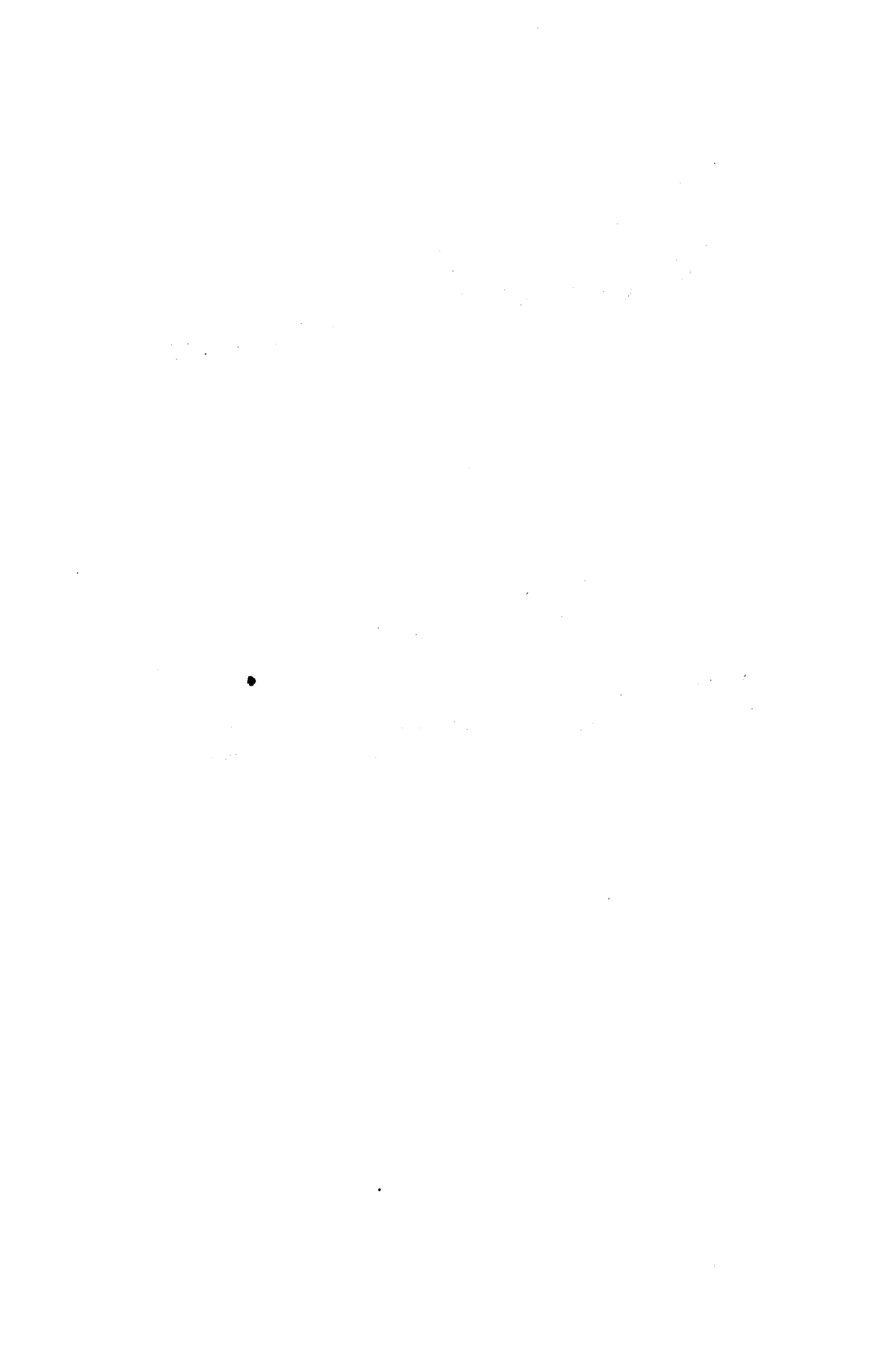

AN ACT to provide for the protection of deer on the island of  
Mount Desert.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt, chase, pursue,  
2 catch or kill any deer at any time in the towns of Eden, Mount  
3 Desert and Tremont, in Hancock county, under the penalty  
4 provided in the general law for illegal hunting or killing of  
5 deer.
