IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to fix the beginning of the open season on fishing in Sebago lake in Cumberland county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Open season for fishing in Sebago lake, in Cum-2 berland county, shall begin April first of each year instead 3 of "when the ice is out" as now provided by law.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
