STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit bait fishing, so called, in certain portions of the Magalleway river and its tributaries and in various ponds in Oxford county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for in any way or
- 2 catch any fish of any kind in the Magalloway river above
- 3 Aziscohos falls, in Oxford county, or in any of the tribu-
- 4 taries of said river north of said Aziscohos falls, or in Sunday
- 5 pond, Long pond, Parmachenee lake, Wells pond, Otter pond,
- 6 Rump pond, Billings ponds, Barker's pond, M. T. Abbey
- 7 pond, Upper and Lower Black ponds, Cupsuptic pond, or
- 8 Lincoln pond, all situated in the county of Oxford, except by

- 9 the ordinary method of casting with artificial flies or fly 10 fishing.
 - Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act 2 shall be subject to the same penalties as provided for illegal 3 fishing in the general law of the State.
