IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 381 of the Private Laws of 1901,
relating to open time on deer in Cumberland county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1 of chapter 381 of the Private and Special Laws
2 of 1901 is hereby amended by inserting after the word
3 "Windham" in the fourth line the words 'Freeport and
4 Pownal,' so that said section as amended shall read as fol-
5 lows:

'Sect. 1. It shall be lawful to hunt, chase, and kill deer in
7 the towns of Baldwin, Bridgton, Casco, Gorham, Gray, Har-
8 rison, Naples, New Gloucester, Otisfield, Raymond, Sebago,
9 Standish, Windham, Freeport and Pownal in Cumberland
10 county, from October first to November first.'
