
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT for the protection of the wild hare or rabbit.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. There shall be a close time on wild hare or rab-
- 2 bits in which it shall be unlawful to hunt, catch or pursue
- 3 them, or have them in possession, during the months of June,
- 4 July and August of each year, under a penalty of ten dollars
- 5 and costs for each offense.
- Sect. 2. It shall be unlawful to use any snares, traps or
- 2 other device in the hunting, pursuing or killing of the com-
- 3 mon wild hare or rabbits, or to hunt or kill the same except
- 4 in the ordinary method of shooting with guns in the usual
- 5 manner.
