STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to incorporate Washington County General Hospital.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. John A. McDonald of East Machias, Frank L.
2 Shaw, Samuel B. Hunter and A. L. Smith of Machias, R. L.
3 Holland of Calais, James B. Grady of Eastport, Fred A.
4 Chandler of Addison, and Geo. A. Sawyer of Milbridge, and
5 their associates, are hereby created a corporation, and a body
6 politic under the name Washington County General Hospital,
7 with all the powers and privileges of similar corporations.

Sect. 2. Said corporation is authorized to establish, main-
2 tain and carry on a hospital at Machias in the county of
3 Washington, for the treatment of persons requiring the aid

4 of medical or surgical skill, care and attendance, and for the
5 purpose of conducting a training school for nurses.

Sect. 3. Said corporation is authorized and empowered for
2 the purposes of its organization, to receive, take and hold, by
3 deed, devise, bequest, or otherwise, property, personal and
4 real, to the amount of two hundred and fifty thousand dollars.

Sect. 4. Any two of the incorporators named in this act
2 may call the first meeting of this company, which shall be held
3 at said Machias, by mailing a written notice, postage paid, to
4 each of the other corporators, seven days at least before the
5 day of meeting, naming the time and place in said Machias,
6 and purposes of such meeting.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
