STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT fixing the beginning of the open season for fishing in
Little Sebago pond, in the towns of Gray and Windham, in
Cumberland county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The open time for fishing in Little Sebago pond,
2 in the towns of Gray and Windham, in Cumberland county,
3 shall begin as soon as the ice is out of said pond instead of on
4 June 15th as now provided by law.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
