IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

---

AN ACT to repeal so much of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes,  
as amended by chapter 42, section 5, of the Public Laws of  
1899, as prohibits fishing in Parlin stream, in Somerset county,  
from the mouth of Bean brook to Long pond.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. So much of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes,  
2 as amended by chapter 42, section 5, of the Public Laws of  
3 1899, as prohibits fishing in Parlin stream, in Somerset  
4 county, from the mouth of Bean brook to Long pond, is  
5 hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
