STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to repeal so much of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 5 of chapter 42 of the Public Laws of 1899, and as amended by chapter 230 of the Private and Special Laws of 1901, as prohibits fishing through the ice in Large Greenwood pond in Elliottsville and Willimantic, in Piscataquis county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. So much of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes, 2 as amended by section 5 of chapter 42 of the Public Laws of 3 1899, and as amended by chapter 230 of the Private and 4 Special Laws of 1901, as prohibits fishing through the ice in 5 Large Greenwood pond, in Elliottsville and Willimantic, in 6 Piscataquis county, is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
