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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT to prohibit the sale of any kind of fish, except eels,  
taken from certain ponds in Kennebec and Somerset Counties.

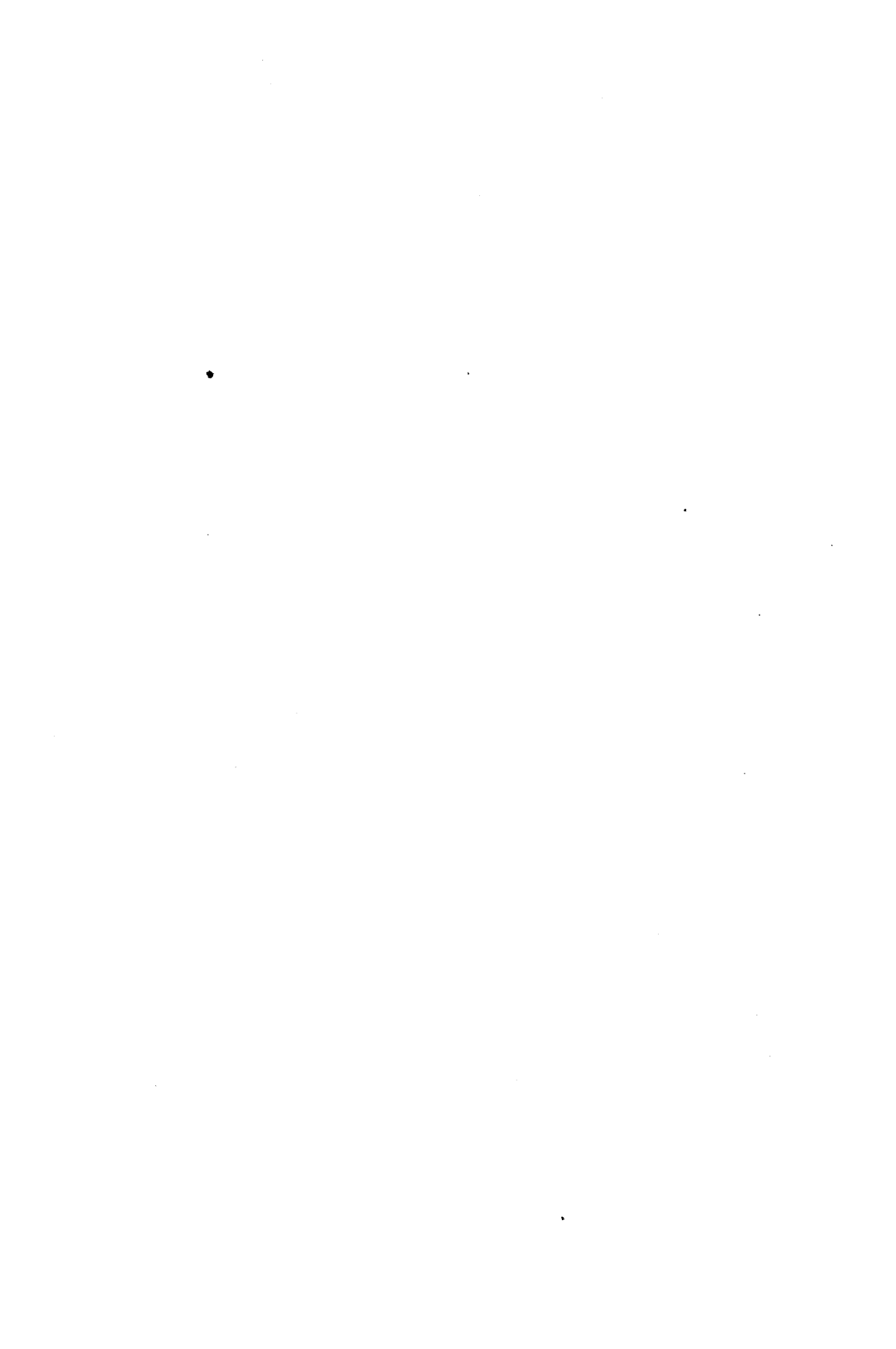
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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, or  
2 offer for sale, any kind of fish, except eels, at any time, taken  
3 from any of the following named lakes and ponds and their  
4 tributaries lying wholly or in part in the counties of Kenne-  
5 bec and Somerset, to wit: East, North, Little, Great, Long,  
6 McGraw, Ellis and Snow ponds, under a penalty of not less  
7 than ten nor more than thirty dollars and costs for each  
8 offense, and a further fine of one dollar for each fish sold  
9 in violation of this law.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect May first, 1903.
