
## STATE OF MAINE.

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit fishing in Morrill pond in the county of Somerset.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch, or kill any kind 2 of fish in Morrill pond in the county of Somerset at any time 3 before the first day of April, A. D. 1905; whoever violates 4 the provision of this section shall be subject to the same penal-5 ties as provided for illegal fishing in the general law. . . .
