IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit fishing in Morrill pond in the county of
Somerset.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch, or kill any kind
2 of fish in Morrill pond in the county of Somerset at any time
3 before the first day of April, A. D. 1905; whoever violates
4 the provision of this section shall be subject to the same penal-
5 ties as provided for illegal fishing in the general law.
